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1. Make sure pupils have what they need to log in

All pupils will need:

- **A Core5-ready device** (computer or iPad)
- **Headphones or earbuds.**
- **Login information:** A printed login card for each student ready for distribution. (see step 4)
- **Access to the Core5 Pupil Program** (via iPad app or with the school's custom URL.)

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2. Introduce your pupils to Core5

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3. Prepare for Auto Placement

- Pupils will start [Auto Placement](#) the first time they log in to Core5.
- Explain the purpose of Auto Placement and that it is a one-time activity to help pupils get started.
- They should complete the Auto Placement activity under teacher supervision.
- Encourage your pupils to do their best work so they will be placed at a level in the program that is just right for them!
- When pupils complete Core5 Auto Placement, they are automatically logged out. When they log in again, they will begin at their assigned level.

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4. Time to log in!

- **Provide log in cards only after Lexia and Auto Placement has been fully introduced.**
- **Logging in on a web browser:** Have students navigate to lexiacore5.com or ideally your school's custom link for Core5. [Learn more about custom links.](#)
- **Logging in on an iPad:** Have pupils open the Core5 app on the iPad.
- **Pupils should be supported throughout the session by a trained member of staff.**

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5. Make sure your pupils know how to log out.

- When it is time to stop working, show your pupils how to log out of Core5.
- Look for the logout button in the upper right of the Core5 window. Pupils will need to confirm log out so they get back to the log in screen.
- When pupils log out of Core5, they will get credit for all the minutes they spent in the program. If they don't log out, some minutes may not be recorded.
- Make sure to visit myLexia to access useful reports and resources.
