
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
About the data

This report is based on data collected from 64,959 students across 888 primary schools during the academic year from September 2023 to July 2024.

These schools each utilised over 40% of their purchased Lexia licenses.



Student Demographics



This broad dataset provides a comprehensive view of how Lexia Core5 Reading impacts students across different stages of primary education.

Lexia Core5 Usage Overview

Lexia Core5 Reading is designed to provide personalised learning for students, targeting their specific needs while supporting teachers with data-driven insights. During the 2023-2024 academic year, students engaged with the program at varying levels, resulting in notable improvements in their reading abilities.

Targeted Usage: Students who adhered to the recommended 60 minutes per week of Lexia Core5 usage saw significantly enhanced outcomes, with an average total usage time of 3,263 minutes.

Average Student Usage: Students spent an average of 912 minutes using Lexia Core5 over the course of the year. This equates to about 15 minutes per week, illustrating that even modest engagement can contribute to literacy growth.




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Weekly Usage and Progress

Regular engagement with Lexia Core5 is crucial for maximising student progress. The data shows that students who used the program for the recommended 60 minutes per week experienced significant improvements in their reading skills, making approximately **15 months** of progress*.



Key Stage 1:	Average progress of 17.09 months.
Lower Key Stage 2:	Average progress of 15.43 months.
Upper Key Stage 2:	Average progress of 13.82 months.

These results demonstrate the effectiveness of consistent weekly usage in advancing students' reading levels well beyond what is typically expected within a single academic year.

Key Features of Lexia Core5 Reading


Real-Time Progress Monitoring: Teachers receive real-time data on student progress, allowing them to intervene early and support students who need additional help.

*Months of Growth (approx.) figure converts students' "units gained" in Core5 into a time-based measurement to understand student progress. In order to complete four levels (1 year equivalent) over a standard 10-month school year, students need to complete about 28 units per month. Months of growth approx. = student's units gained out of 28.



Yearly Usage and Progress

Sustained use of Lexia Core5 throughout the school year leads to even more significant gains in reading progress. The data reveals a clear correlation between the number of weeks students engage with the program and the amount of progress they make.



Progress with 32 Weeks Use:

- Key Stage 1: 11.50 months of progress
- Lower Key Stage 2: 10.23 months of progress
- Upper Key Stage 2: 9.50 months of progress

Progress with 39 Weeks Use:

- Key Stage 1: 17.51 months of progress
- Lower Key Stage 2: 15.38 months of progress
- Upper Key Stage 2: 11.51 months of progress

This data underscores the importance of getting students started with Lexia Core5 as early as possible in the academic year. The more consistently students use the program, the more substantial their reading progress.


